Voting in West Haven

Qualifications:

To become a registered voter, you must be a US citizen, at least 18 years old of age by Election Day, and be registered in West Haven.

Registration:

For the general election, register in person, with identification at the office of the West Haven City Clerk or Registrar of Voters. You can also register to vote at the Connecticut Secretary of State Office or online at: https://voterregistration.ct.gov/OLVR/welcome.do . To register by mail, obtain an application from the City Clerk, Registrar of Voters, public libraries, public schools, or government agencies. Once filled in, mail the application to the West Haven Registrar of Voters. You may enroll in a political party or remain unaffiliated. You must re-register after moving to another town and must notify the registrars after moving within West Haven.

For a primary election, you must be registered to vote and enrolled in the party by noon the day before the election. If you are switching parties, to vote in a party primary, you must be registered with that new party ,three months before the primary election.

Absentee Ballots:

If you are unable to vote in person on Election Day, you may request an absentee ballot from the City Clerk, available six (6) weeks before regular or primary election.

*If you have been convicted of a felony and sentenced to probation or parole, you may restore your right to vote. Contact the Registrar of Voters for details.
